## **Hot Cocoa Mix**

### Ingredients:

1	box	Nestle Quick (1 lb)
1	jar	dry creamer mix (11-12 oz)
1	box	powdered milk (8 qt)
1	cup	powdered sugar
1/2	cup	cocoa

### Instructions:

Mix all ingredients. Store in gallon ice cream container.

Serve 1/4 to 1/3 cup mix with 1 cup hot water.

### Notes:

Any dry creamer typically used for coffee works well. We usually use Cremora brand, but there's nothing special about it.

### Options:

- can add a dash of cinnamon and nutmeg to each cup
- can add 1 cup malted to batch to make it a bit more creamy

We first met Maggie and Jerry when we were building our first house in SE Rochester. It was late fall 1990 and rather cold. Jerry invited us over for some hot cocoa to warm up. We really liked the cocoa, but it took us eight years before we got around to copying it down and putting it into our recipe book. Of course, we've modified the recipe a bit over the years, but it's basically the same with a few tweaks.
